¹ John 5.43. Text is only on one side; the verso(?) side looks it had been glued down to something, since there is material now adhering to it in places, and some of the parchment seems to have been violently removed. It also looks as though a strip of masking tape is on the verso side.

The text of John 5.43 ends with the last word of the verse, followed by a large gap to the end of the line.

ονομα]τι τω ιδιω εκινον λη[μ?
ψεσθαι

The end of the line looks like it has been cut off in part because it is cut at an angle, suggesting that this is not simply the inner margin of the text. But whether the verb was λημψεσθαι [essentially the Alexandrian reading] or ληψεσθαι [essentially the Byzantine reading] is impossible to tell.
